Terminated from Participating in the Child and Adult Care Food Program**

7 C.F.R. §226.6 (b)(1)(xi), 7 C.F.R. §226.6 (b)(2)(ii) prohibits the state agency from approving an institution's application if the institution or any of its principals is on the National disqualified list. The state agency is prohibited from approving an application submitted by a sponsoring organization on behalf of a facility if the facility or any of its principals is on the national disqualified list. Furthermore, a sponsoring organization is prohibited from submitting an application on behalf of a facility if either the facility or any of its principals is on the National disqualified list.

Attached to this memorandum is a list of terminated Institutions, Terminated Individuals, Terminated Day Care Homes, and Terminated Day Care Home Providers, who once participated in the CACFP in North Carolina and is now on the National Disqualified List. Please consult this list to ensure that none of your facilities or the responsible principals is on this list.
